Green Technologies in FDPs

Wikipedia states that "Green technology is the application of the environmental science and green chemistry to conserve the natural environment and resources, and to curb the negative impacts of human involvement."

What does that mean when it comes to FDPs?

Is a display green if it meets Energy Star goals?

Or if it has an LED backlight? Or if it is EPEAT or TCO certified?

Today, there is no clear definition as to what makes a display green and no approved benchmarks by which to judge the greenness of a display-based product. Display-based product makers need to consider and/or comply with dozens of labeling, regulatory and legislative initiatives.

Furthermore, green has different meanings and implications depending on where you are in the value chain.
